



Call for Posters and Demonstrations

Scope

CySeP is interested in showcasing achievements through invited and submitted posters and demonstrations. The focus is exactly on the design, development, and experiences with security and privacy technologies in every-day life and business.

Alongside a captivating program, we expect this is to offer attendees a broad and comprehensive exposure to the latest and hottest from major stakeholders. At the same time, we want to provide a stage to up-and-coming solutions and their providers, with exposure to a top-notch expert audience from industry and academia.

We are particularly interested in European and National Projects and their on-going or recent achievements. We are equally enticed to see achievements and proposals by European, Nordic, and Swedish companies and research institutes; always aligned with the event theme.

Visibility

Each poster/demo accepted to CySeP will also be presented by a short talk during one of two special sessions during the week. This will provide an opportunity to access the entire audience. At the same time, all attendees will have ample time to visit posters/demos.

We provide two poster and demo sessions, Mon-Tue, 10/27-28, and Thu-Fri, 10/30-31, to provide flexibility to presenters and a broader stage, welcoming more numerous contributions. Presenters can indicate if they wish to have their posters/demos present throughout the week. If not, storage will be provided.

Instructions

We welcome proposals submitted as an abstract, maximum two A4 pages long, double-column, max. font size 10, with reasonable margins. This, in PDF format, should describe the envisioned contribution, motivate how it relates to the event theme and why it could spark discussions. It should also provide information about the presenters and their organizations and any special needs for the setup/presentation.
